Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height division.

Preferred classes will run with the corresponding regular classes and height divisions. Final running order will be determined after entries close.

Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Christie Bowers texdandy@gmail.com. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Online Entries: This trial is accepting online entries through www.labtestedonline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 175 runs online (50%), 175 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Go www.labtestedonline.com to create a user account and add your dogs. Then search by state for Texas. Click on the "i" information icon to the right of the club's December trial to create your entry.

Wait-list Policy: The club is offering a wait-list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 25 entries will be placed on the club's wait-list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the trial closing date as listed on the front of this premium. Any entries withdrawn that are received by 6:00 p.m., Dec. 2, 2024 will be replaced by a wait-listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait-list into the trial by 6:00 p.m., Dec. 2, 2024

Move-ups:

Move-ups for the first day of the trial will be accepted in writing prior to 6:00 p.m. on Monday, **Dec. 2, 2024**. Send email move-ups to texdandy@gmail.com. Move-ups for the subsequent days of this trial will be accepted no later than 30 minutes after the completion of the trial on Saturday on forms provided

Entering Mixed Heights or Mixed Classes: Separate entry forms must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred classes and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Confirmation of Receipt of Entry: An initial e-mail will be sent out as entries are processed, typically within 24 hours of the entry being received. Move-ups are confirmed by a new emailed confirmation being sent. If an exhibitor has multiple dogs entered, the updated email will only be for the dog that had the move-up. Final confirmations will go out after the trial has closed.

Change of Entry: Entry changes emailed to the Trial Secretary are not official until the exhibitor has received a return email confirmation from the Trial Secretary.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a **\$30.00** collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

SET-UP AND CHECK-IN

The site will be open for set-up at 7:00 am on Saturday and Sunday.

Check in will be done via the Agility Gate app. The app can be downloaded off the Play Store

Judging will begin no earlier than 8:00 am on Saturday and Sunday.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO) **FEO will be scored as absent in the catalog**

For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.

Toys are allowed in the ring

Toys must be non-audible

Toys may not leave the handler's hand

Toys that roll freely cannot be used

Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring. A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Attention, volunteers!!! NACDA appreciates everyone who helps make our trials successful by contributing their time. We will have sign-up sheets at the check-in table for volunteers to write your name down where you are willing to work. This should eliminate conflicts and give you a chance to choose your job. Fill it out early to grab the spot you want. Workers will receive \$3 worker bucks for each class worked

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, dogs that are blind, and dogs that are taped or bandaged or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes are not eligible to participate.

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS & HEIGHT DIVISIONS

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Measuring of Dogs: Jump height cards do not need to be submitted with the entry form. Indicate on the entry form whether the dog needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked and that the dog is measured prior to running.

The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct height division. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a soccer turf surface. Ring size will be 100 x 110

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings, may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Classes will have ribbons awarded to the 1st through 4th place in each jump height. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. MACH or PACH rosettes and bars will be awarded to those completing a MACH or PACH title. New Title ribbons will be awarded to those completing all other types of agility titles.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS —

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. **NASA Area Companion Dog Association** and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. **NASA Area Companion Dog Association** reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against **NASA Area Companion Dog Association** or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course, **No flexi lines in the covered arena area**

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

"Since bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$15 of the entry fee per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. Written requests for a refund must be made to the Trial Secretary no less than 30 minutes prior to each day's event start time."

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating is available under cover. Crates may be left overnight at the show site; however, **Nasa Area Companion Dog Association** will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Please be aware that the site is a public venue. **Remember to secure all valuables.**

Glass receptacles of any kind are prohibited throughout Lomax Arena grounds.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice **height division** for all **Regular** titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the **Preferred** classes **must** compete at the required jump height and **may not** compete in a jump height division **higher or lower** than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an **Agility Jump Height Card** may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
